A realistic simulation of the rolling of the dig and a very clear representation of the

board make this an enjoyable game.

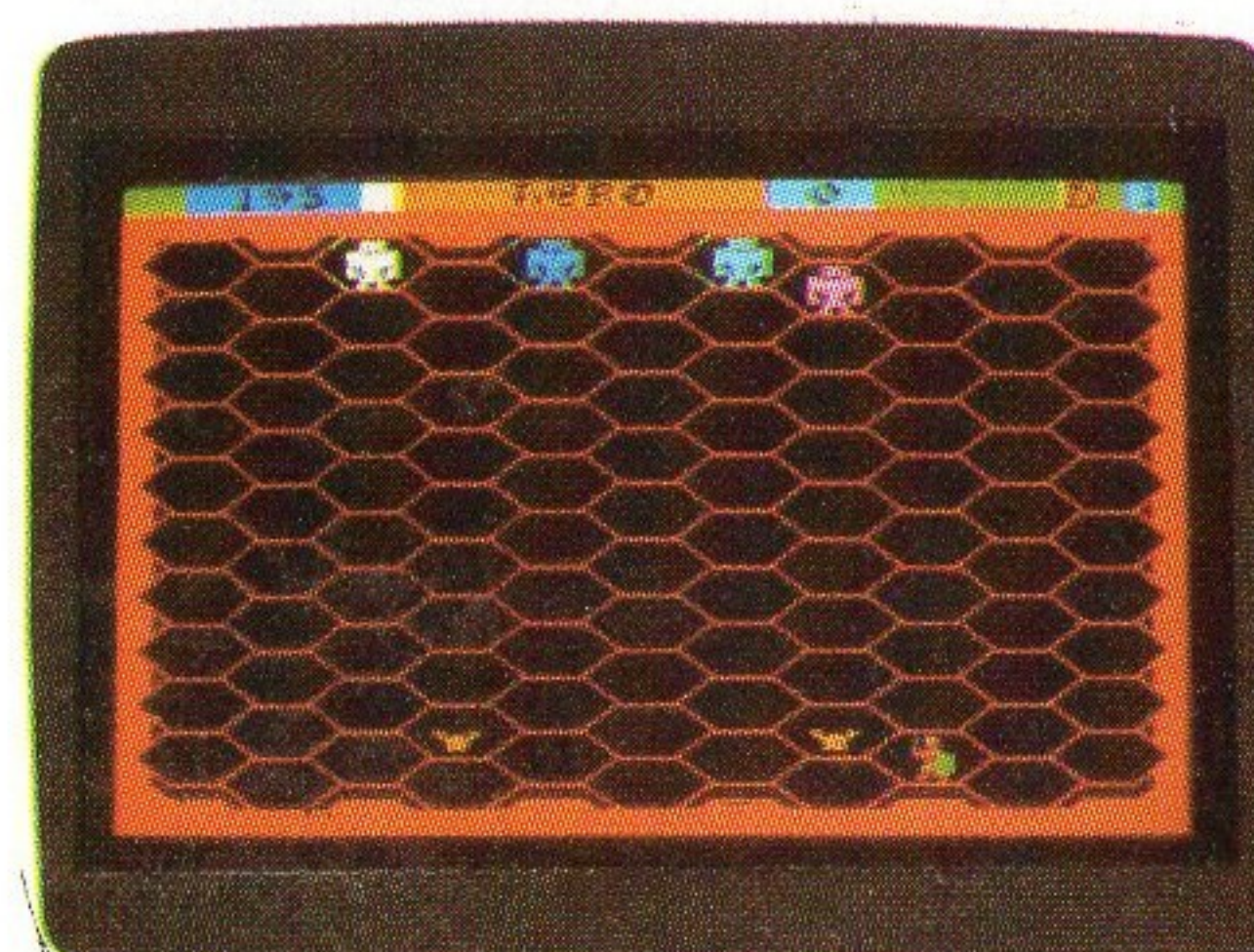


Norseman

This boardgame is played on hexagonal square cells representing the pillars of "The Devils Causeway" and involves hand-to-hand combat with monsters who leap from pillar to pillar. You commence battle with a monster by jumping onto its pillar and a successful encounter leaves the monster dead.

The object of the game is to protect the Golden Helmet of Power from wave after wave of monsters.

There are 10 levels of difficulty and your player may move in any of the six directions shown by the hexagonal pillar. If you jump on a monster, you win, if he jumps on you, he wins.

Willy, the miner, has fallen down his disused mine shaft and commences exploring. Low and behold, Willy uncovers evidence of a lost civilisation, far superior to our own. 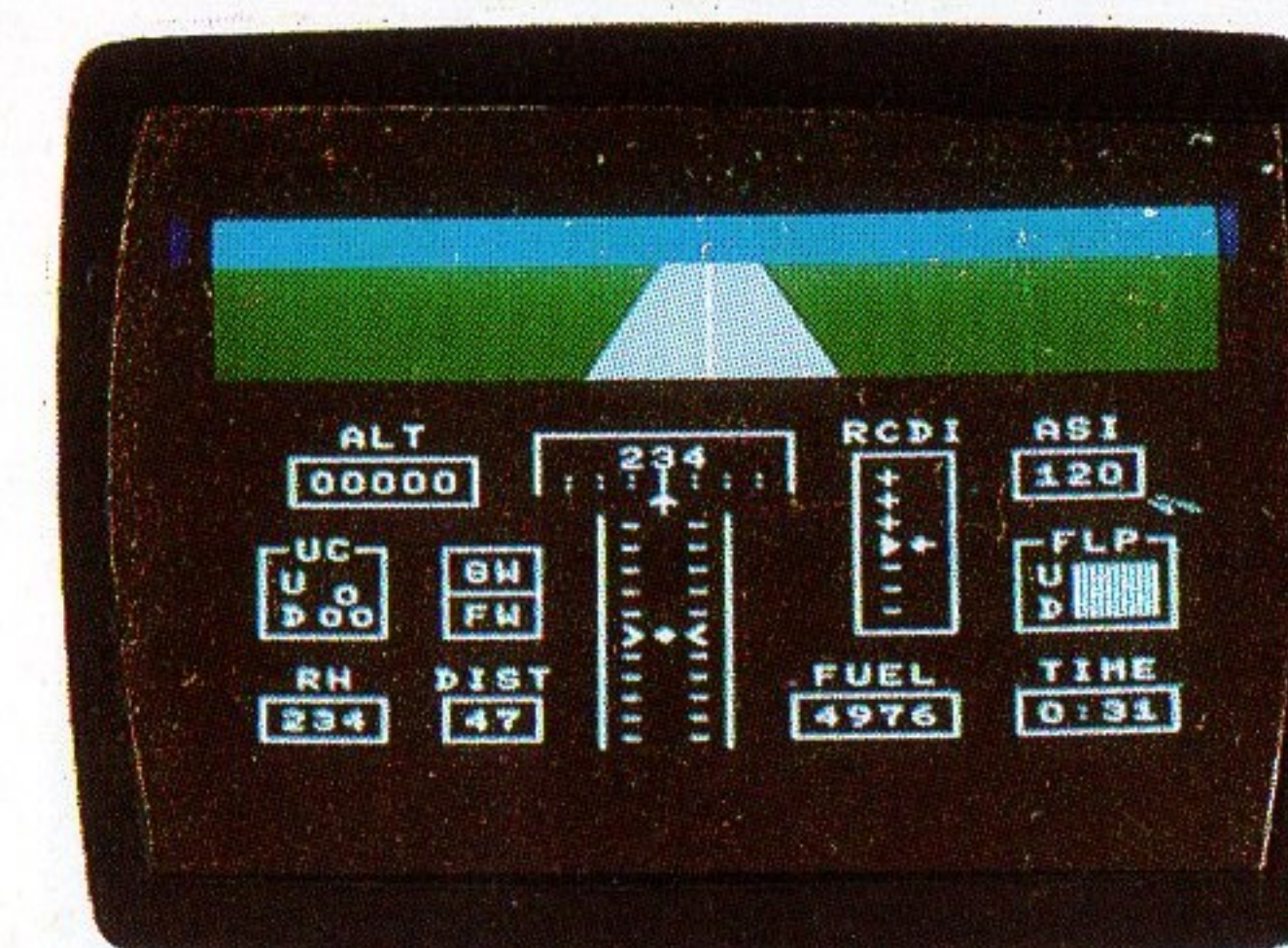

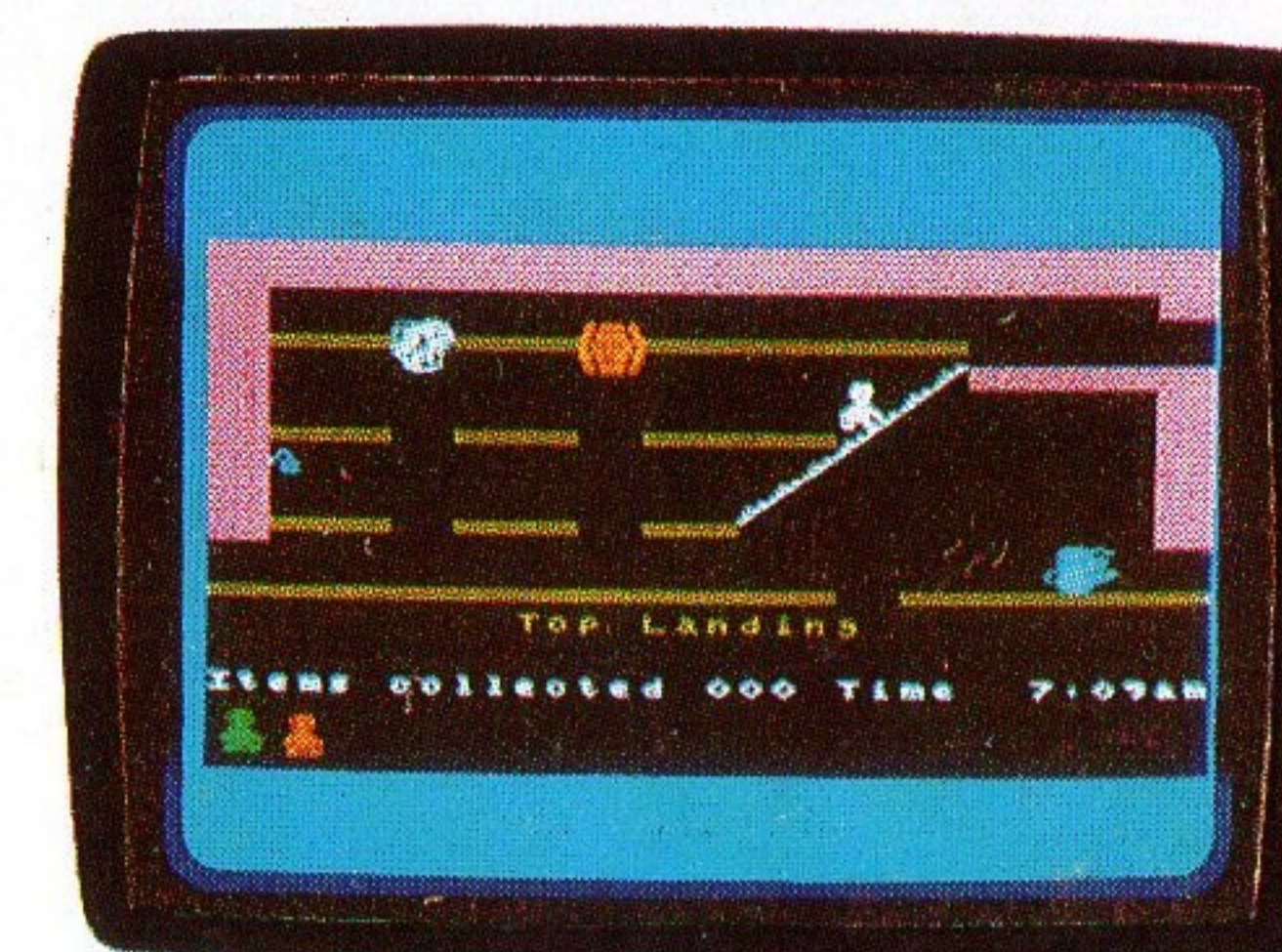
Flight Path 737

As the pilot of this high performance jet airliner, you must take off from an airfield surrounded by high mountains and, having climbed your aircraft safely over them, prepare yourself for a landing at an airfield in the valleys below. You may choose between first solo flight through six levels of difficulty to test pilot. First solo flight gives you mountains that are 5,000 feet high and a runway of 3 miles long with no in-flight hazards. In test pilot, the mountains are 9,200 feet and the runway 1½ miles long with crosswinds and a chance of engine fires.

Le Mans

This is a car racing simulation employing the 3D graphics, and a drive 'eye view' display to achieve stunning realism. Based upon the world famous 24 hour race, it offers you the chance to drive a group 'C' sports car race at speeds of 225 mph!

The car which has a five speed gear box, will automatically change gear depending on the road speed. The race is over 10 laps with 9 cars in the race. You start sixth on the starting grid. You gain points when overtaking and successfully completing laps. Points are deducted for fuel loss and crashes. Good luck!



Superchess

Superchess is a multi-level chess program with seven levels of difficulty from zero to six. Level 0 is the easiest with a response time of 3 seconds and level six takes 12 hours to make a move. Level three is the tournament level with an average response time of 3 minutes per move. Upon loading the disk you are confronted with the options to play a game, analyse a game or ask for help. The analysis mode allows the user to change sides, change the level of play and change the position of the pieces. The player may also, while in the analysis mode, ask for help, clear the board, change the colour of the board and pieces and ask for technical information – the computer method of playing. Upon selecting 'play' you are presented with a fairly large representation of the board and pieces. The squares of the board are displayed in the usual algebraic manner with the files A-H and the ranks 1-8 being shown along the side of the board. Moves are entered in this algebraic format by first typing in the origin square followed by the destination square. You may, if you wish, ask the computer to recommend a move. The computer keeps a check of the moves made and displays them on the left of the board. The program should

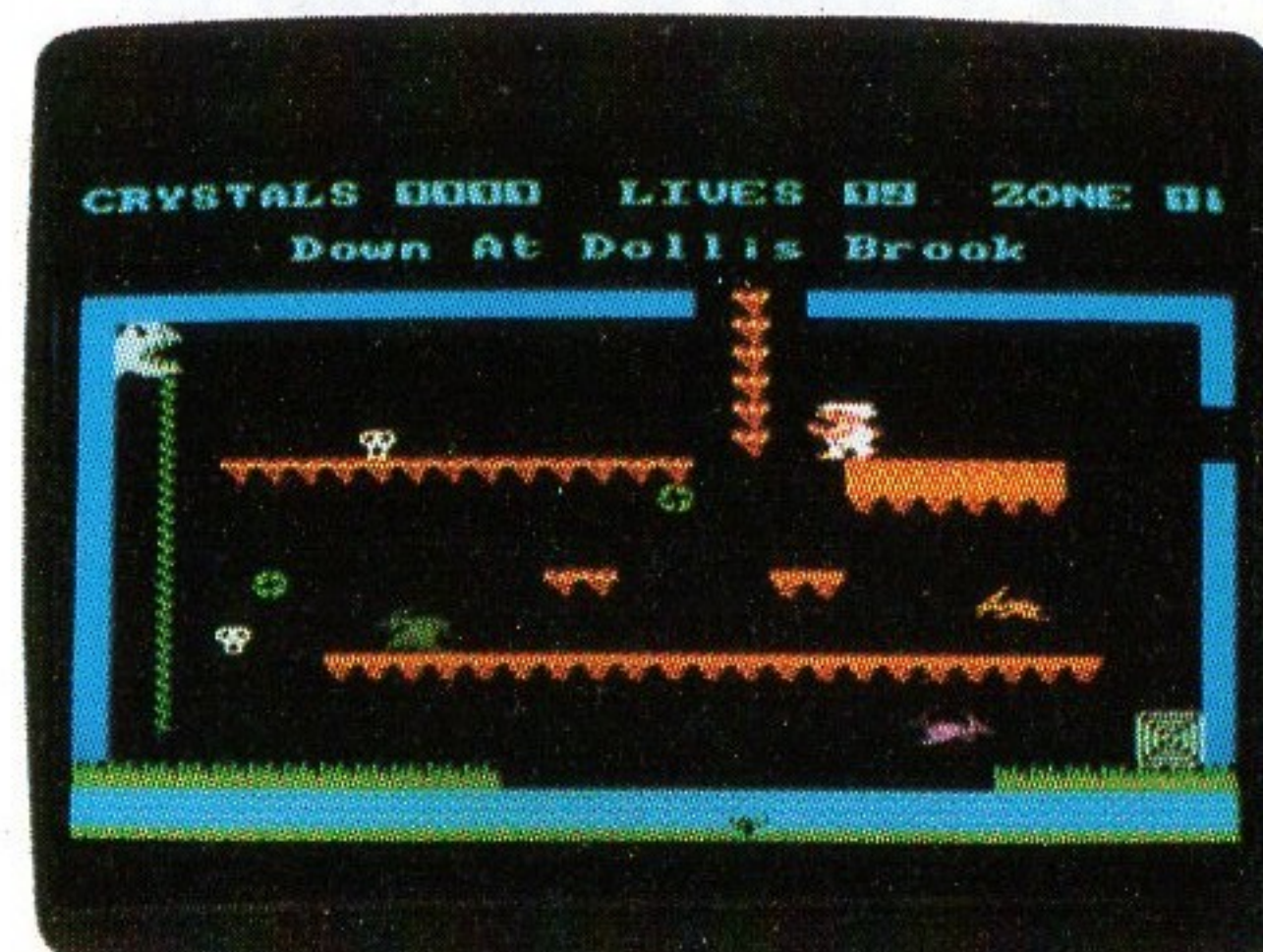
appeal to a wide range of chess players.



Timetrap

A colourful multi-screen 'platform' game where you must wander through time (accompanied by the 'happy wanderer' music) collecting crystals. Each screen has its own dangers ranging from crumbling ice, Greek warriors to flying carpets.

You have the option of using a joystick or the keyboard as you choose your route through the Time Maze.

The Wreck

This game takes place within a sunken ship that you have located on the edge of an undersea ridge. You have only ten refills of your oxygen tanks and if you return to your base to get heavier salvage equipment, the ship will very likely slip off the ridge.

Your task is to recover the gold that is stored in the safe on the lower deck. The captain left clues to the safe's combination at various points around the ship. There are many hazards in the form of deadly fish, located throughout the ship, and these have to be killed or avoided at all cost.

The game is more complex than this short description can hope to show but suffice it to say that comprehensive instructions are included with this 3D-style maze game.



Hustler

This is a pool-orientated game giving you a choice of one or two players.

There are six different types of pool that you can play, ranging from trying to pot any of six balls into any of the six pockets in any order to the more difficult challenge of two players, one trying to pot the balls in order of 1 to 6, and his opponent trying to achieve the same in reverse, 6 to 1.

The cue is represented by a '+' and once your shot is lined up you have the option of putting on side or top spin as well as the power of your shot. The cushions give bounce and there is on-screen scoring. Joystick compatible.



Tournament Snooker

An excellent simulation of this popular game, this version enables the player to achieve total control over the cue ball using strength of shot, direction and spin. A nice feature of this simulation is that if no key is touched for approximately two minutes, the simulation reverts to an excellent demonstration mode, touching any key, there after, will place you back in the game exactly where you left it. Any of your shots can be replaced by pressing the 'R' key. An extremely smooth and accurate simulation.

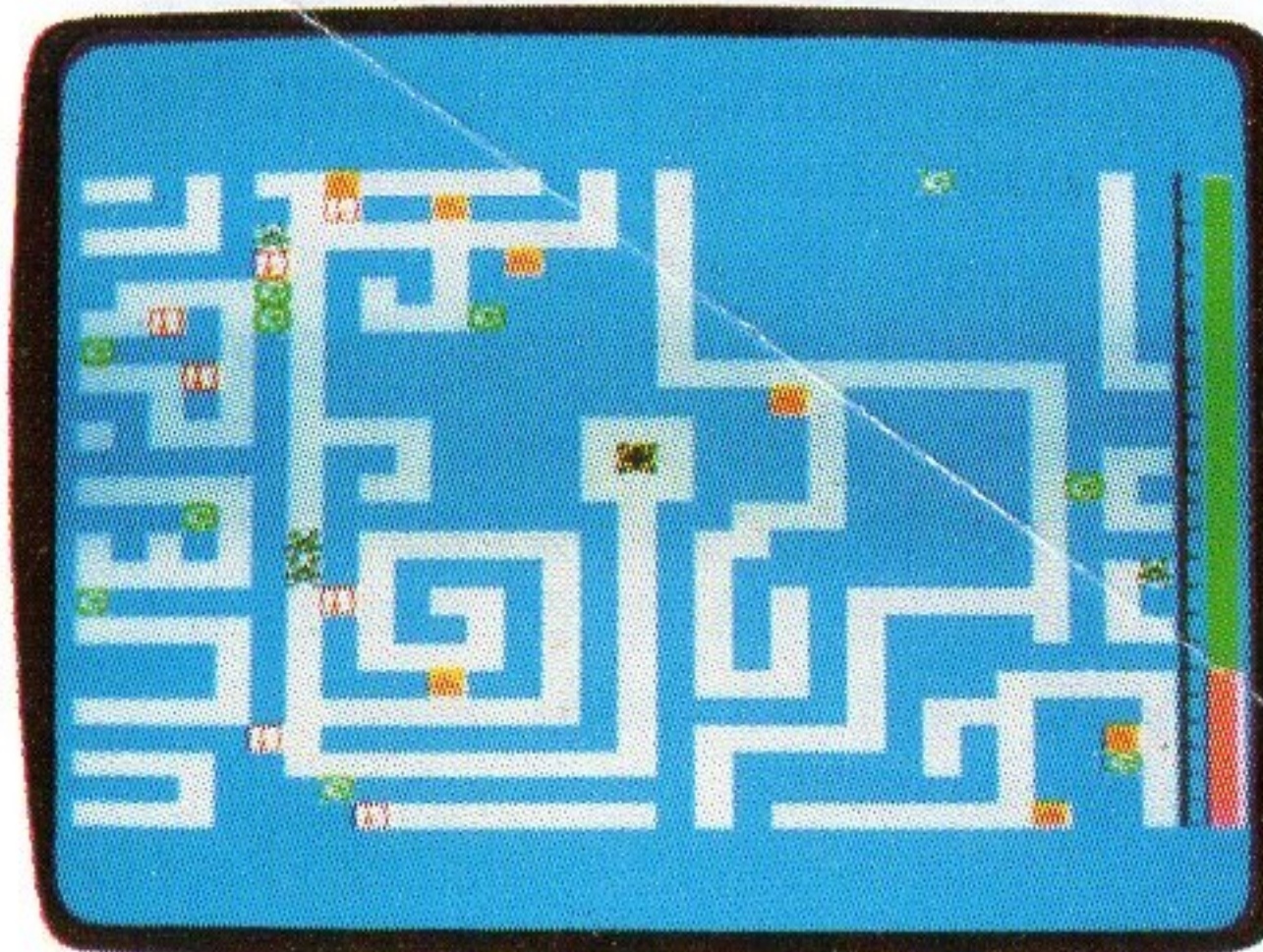
Gronks

An exciting game of skill and luck in which you must find your way around a maze (part of which is displayed at any one time) to a pot of gold and then find your way out.

The Xanagrams display shows empty boxes representing the letters in an interlinking set of words, whilst all the letters making up the words are displayed in alphabetical order on the right of the screen. You have to assign the correct letter to each box, but do not be deceived, it is much harder than it first appears. There are three levels of difficulty and a random selection of over 5,000 words.



Quadrax

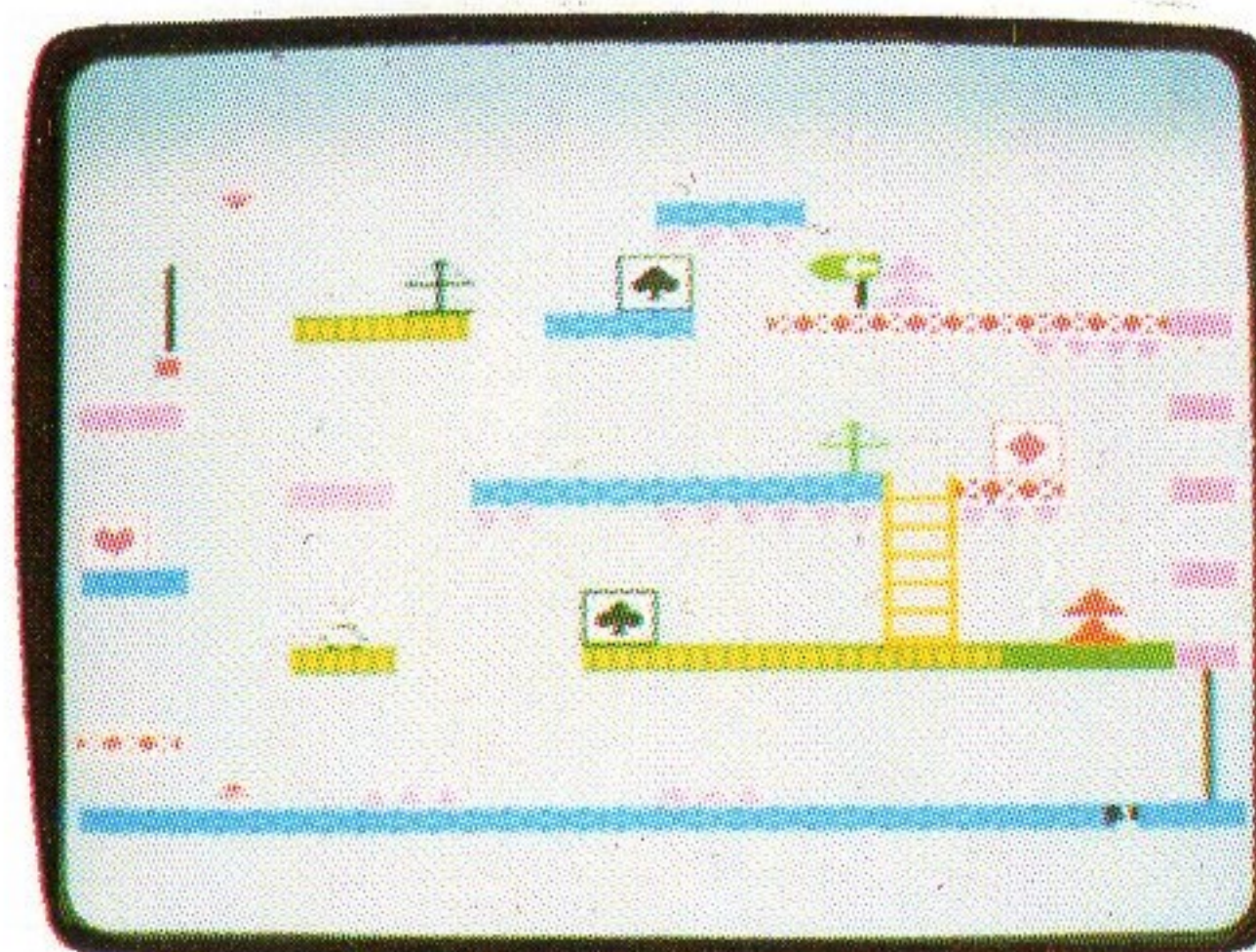
is a game for two players or you can play against the computer. The aim of the game is to achieve a straight line of a chosen number (3 to 8) of adjoining counters in a vertical, horizontal or diagonal direction, while

at the same time foiling your opponents attempts to do the same. The counter falls to the lowest vacant space in the column selected. This game is sometimes known as 'Four-in-a-row'.



Fu Kung in Vegas

A platform game over many screens where you, as the character Fu-Kung, must collect all the playing cards that are scattered around the many screens that make-up the game. A variety of obstacles hamper your journey and the game is anything but easy. A joystick may be used and certainly helps in you achieving your goal.



Super Six Game Pack

This package offers excellent value and possesses a combination of games which will keep anybody entertained for hours. With PHROGGY you must carefully cross both a road and a river to get to the safety of a lilly pad. With TRAXMAN you must kill a centipede, but beware, because the devious little beast breaks up. NVADERS is a game along the lines of Space Invaders and maintains its popularity with this version. DEFLECT is a game of skill which involves deflecting a ball onto a target. 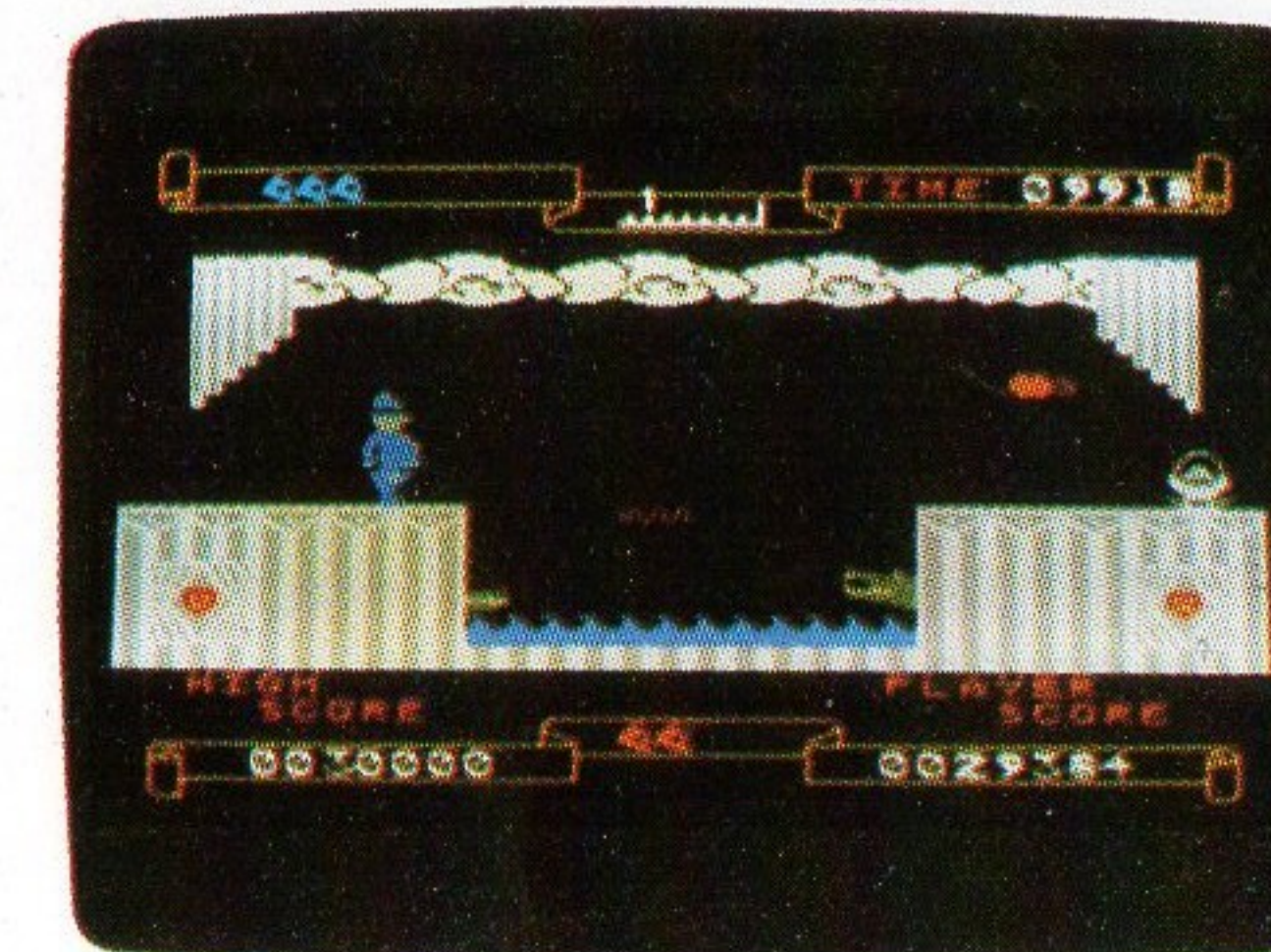


Punchy

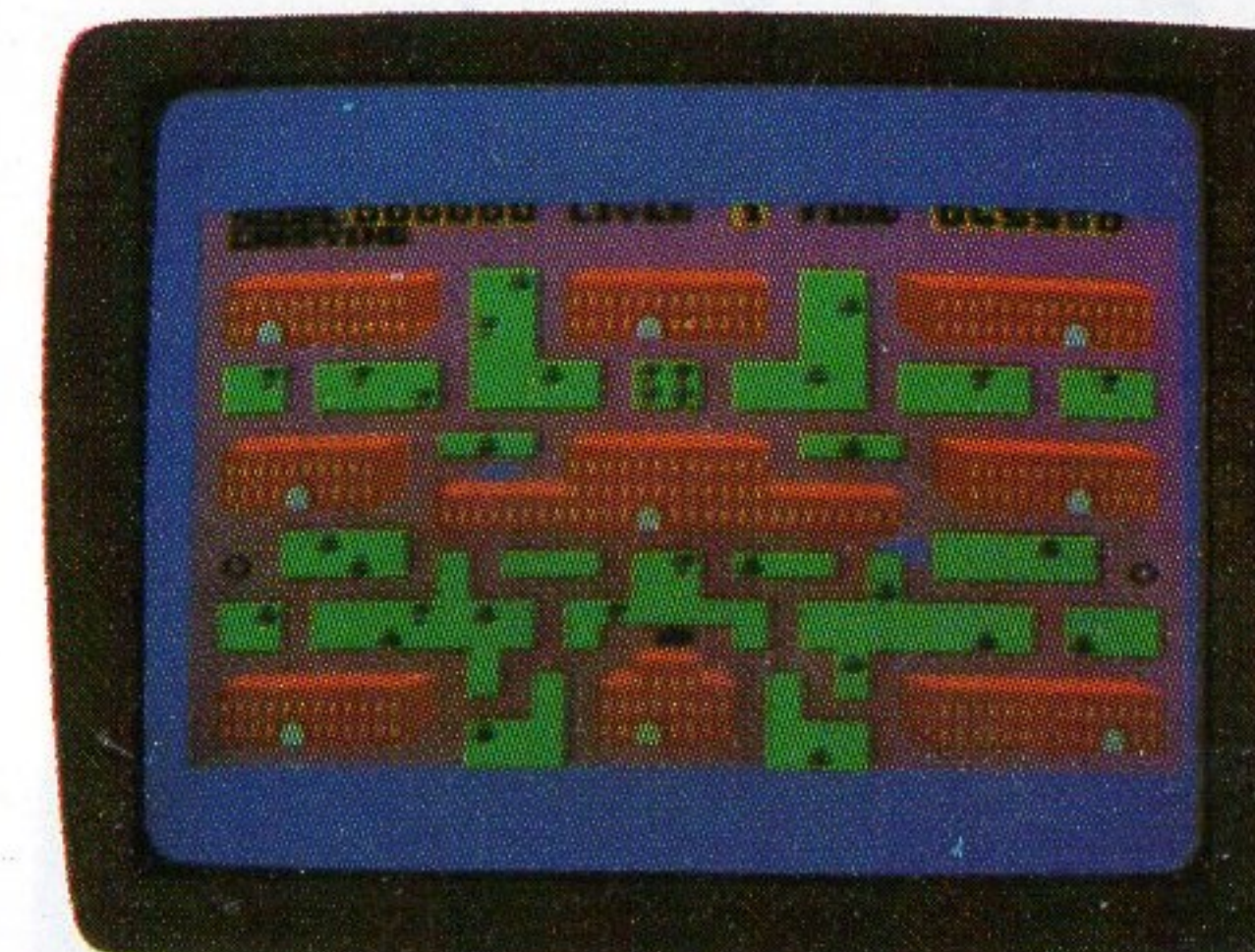

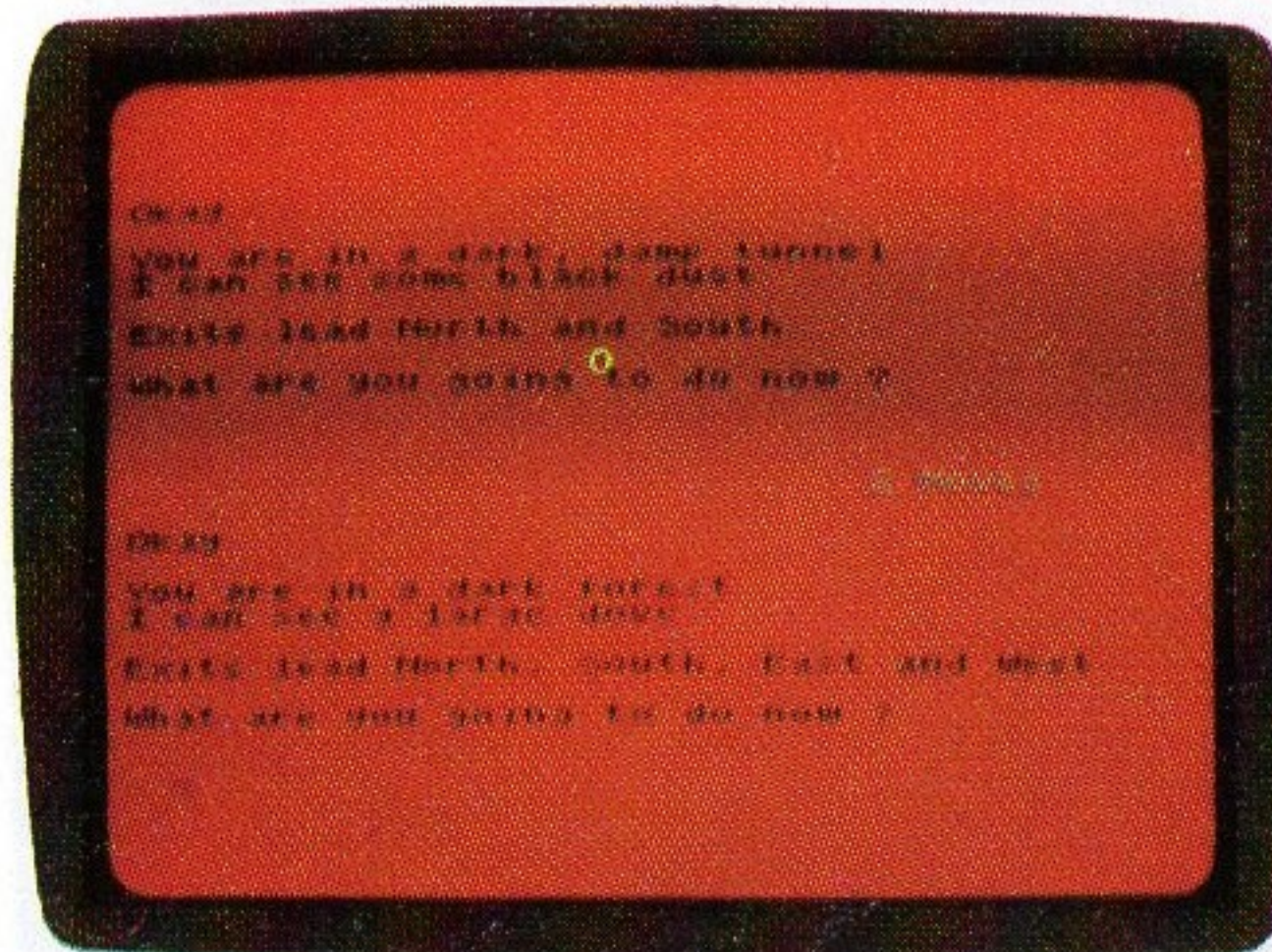

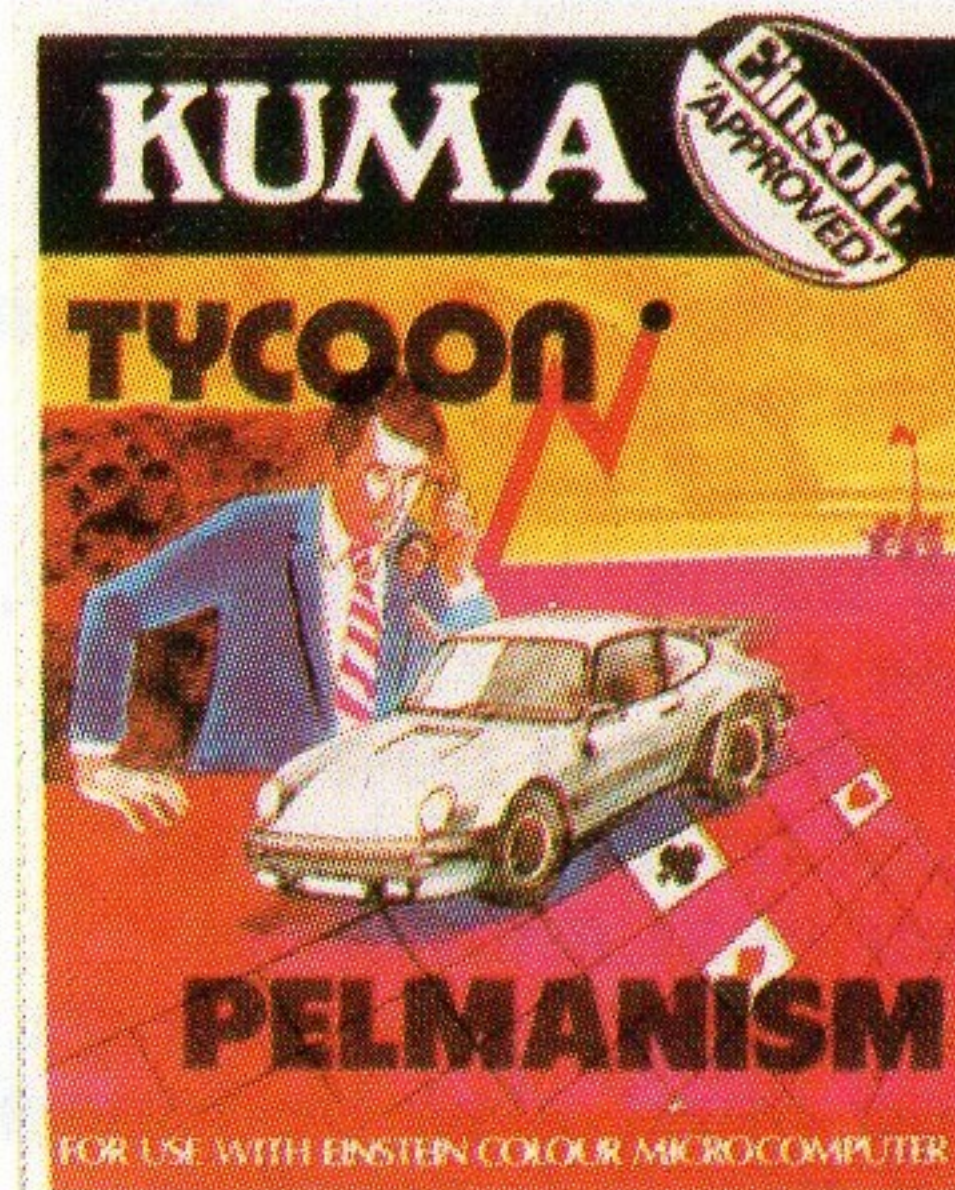
Encounter

is a game in which paratroopers are swooping down to capture your gun emplacement. You can either shoot down the aircraft before they drop the troops or pick off the parachutists as they descend.

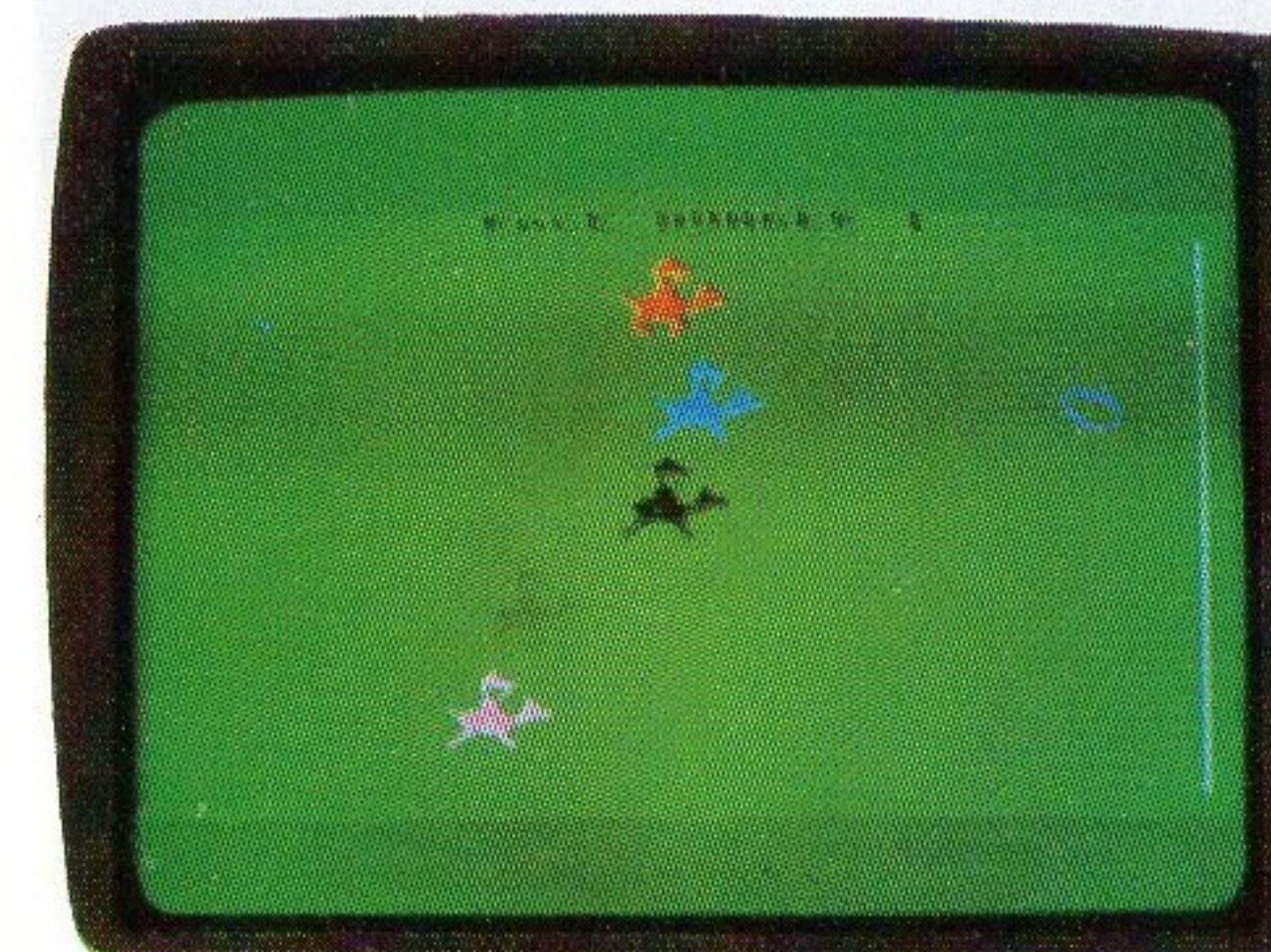
In **Gold Miner** you have to identify the real gold from the fake and then find your way out of the gold mine.

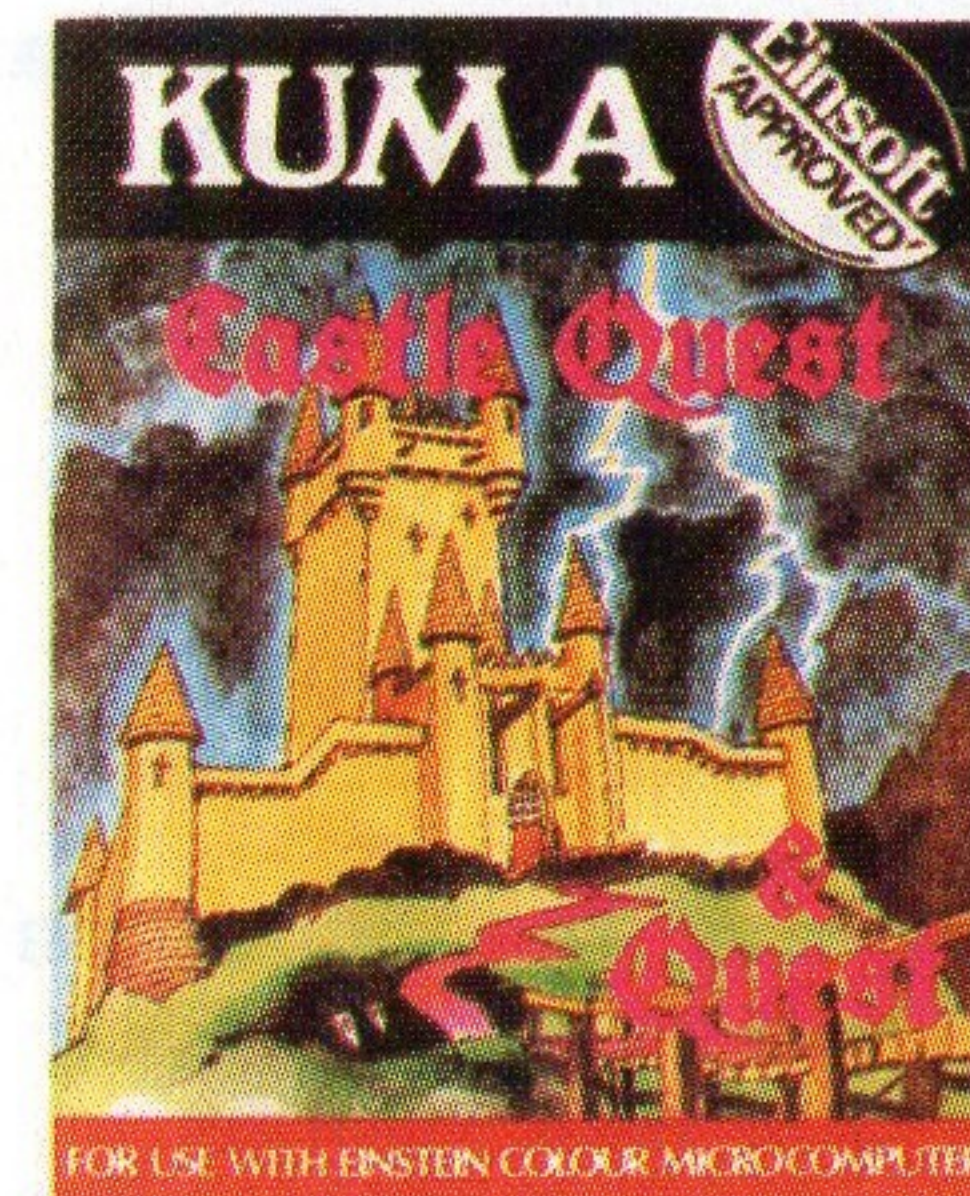
Millipede

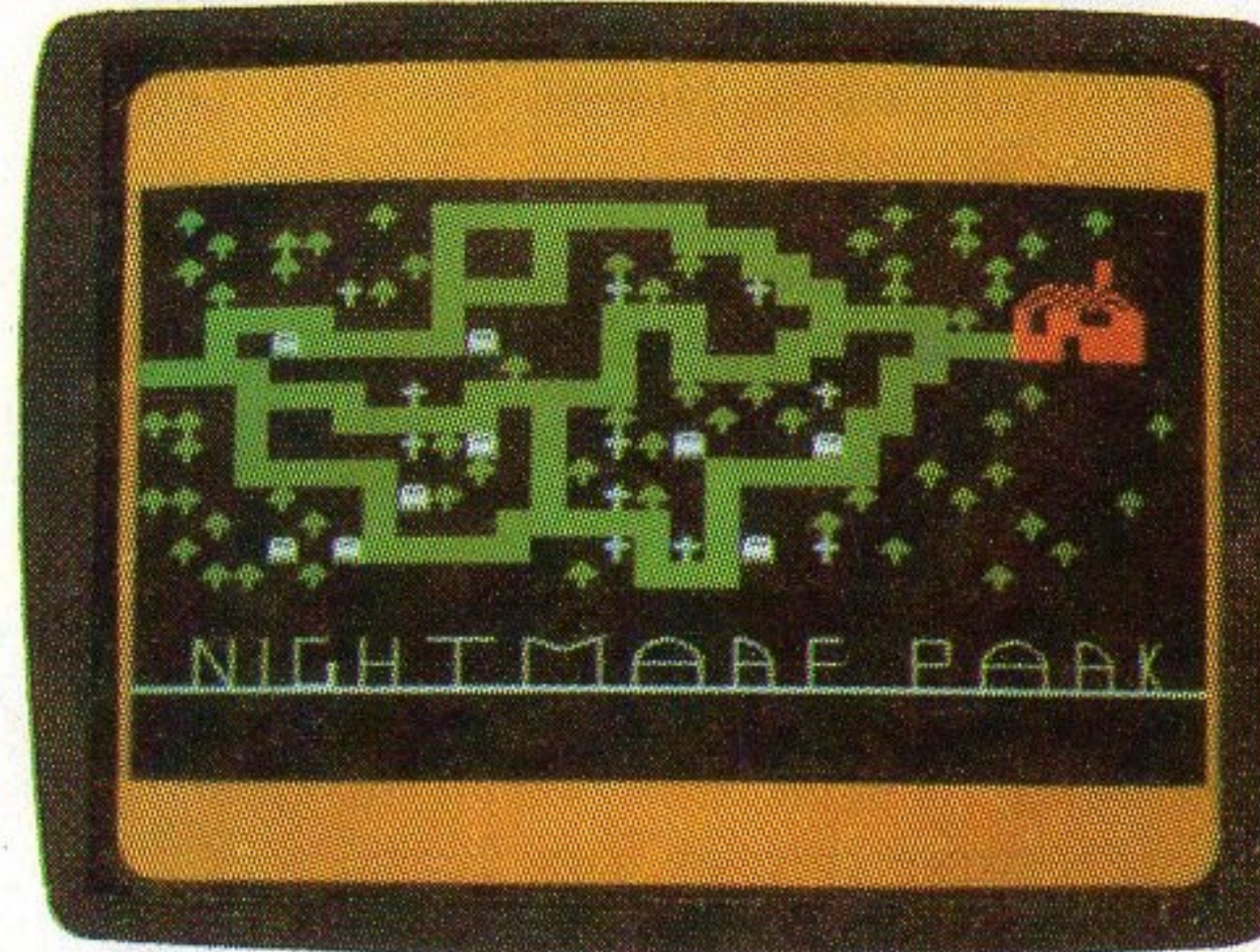
Chuckie Egg

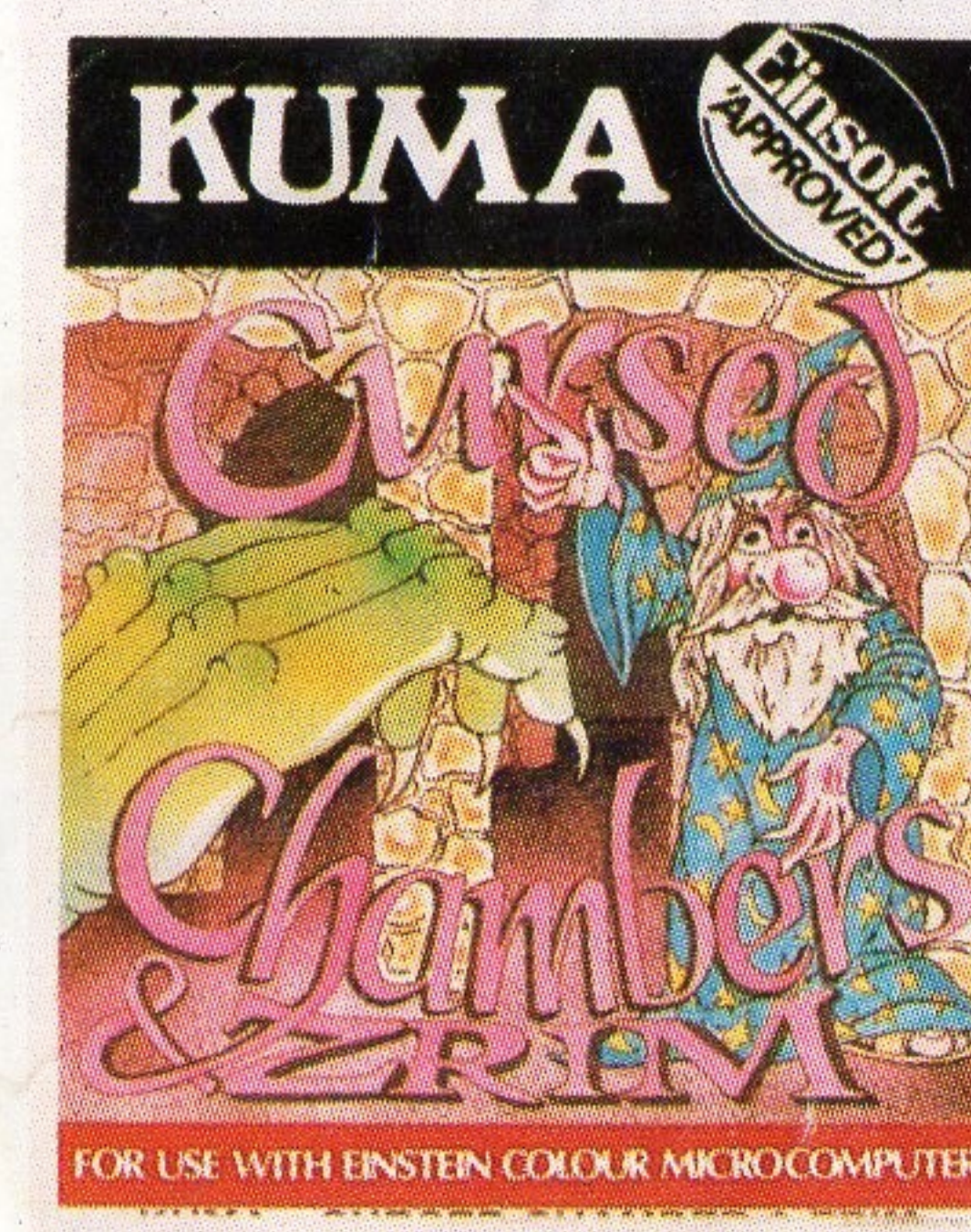
Music Composer

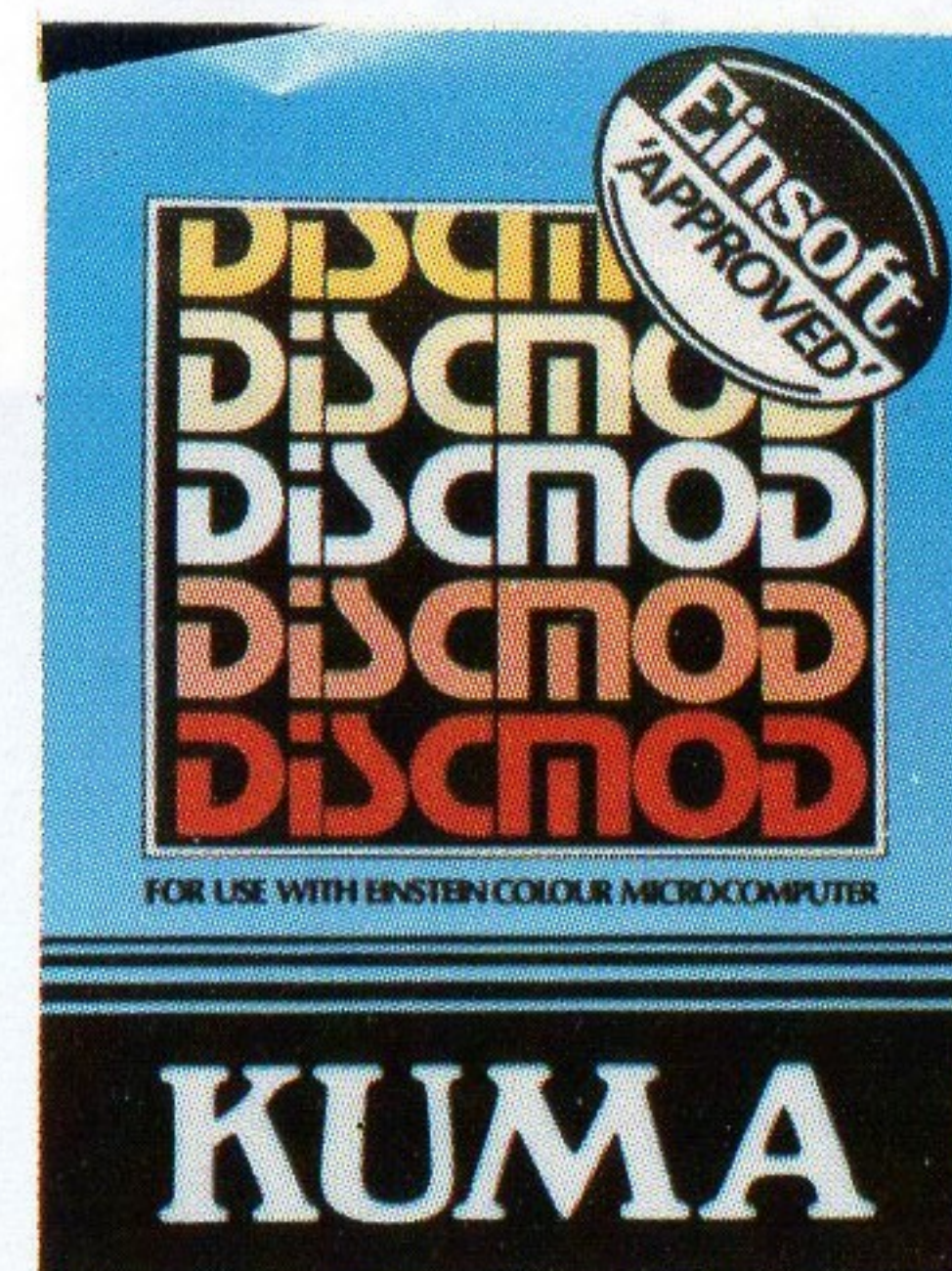


Mr Fixit

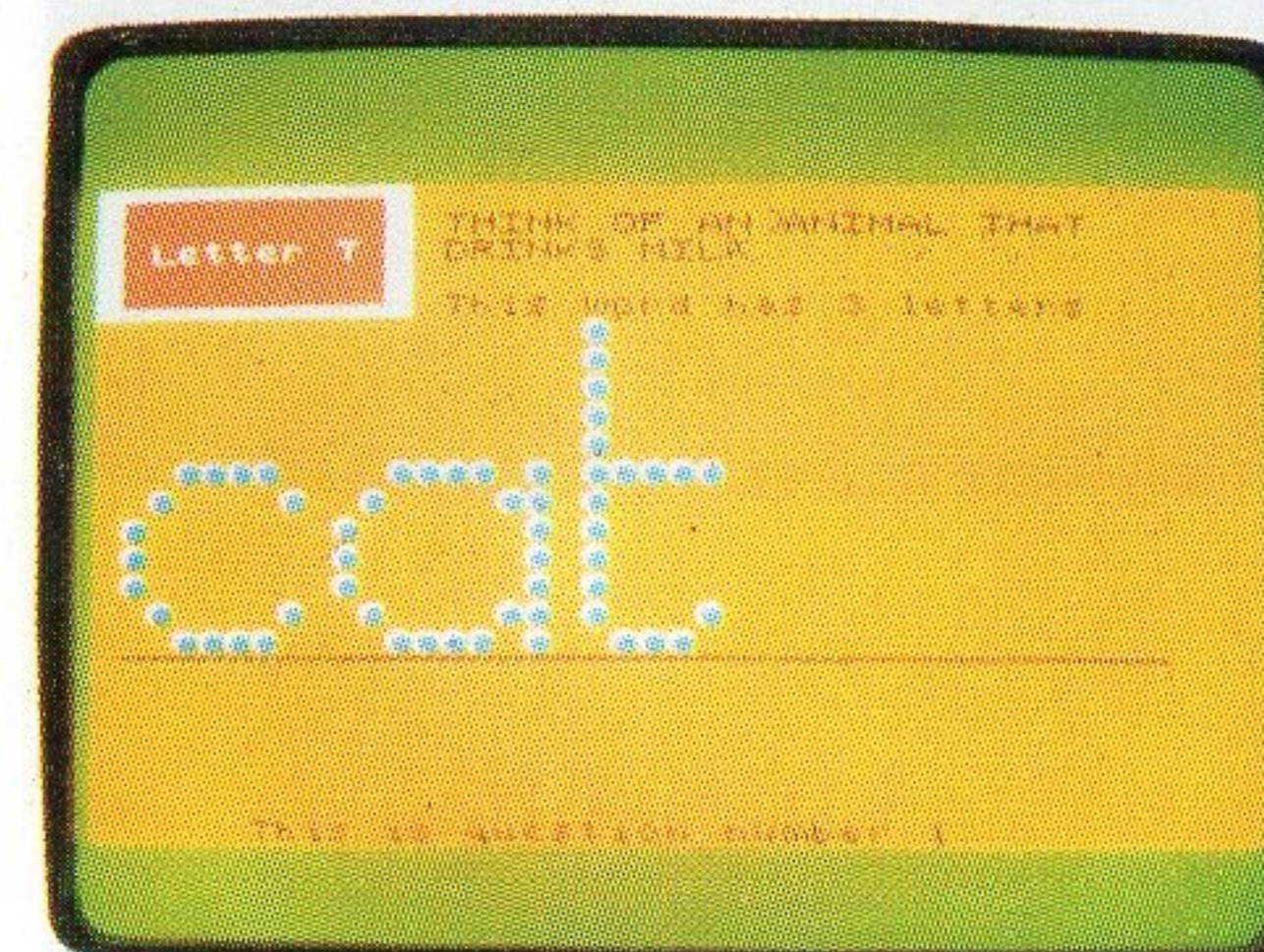
Discmod

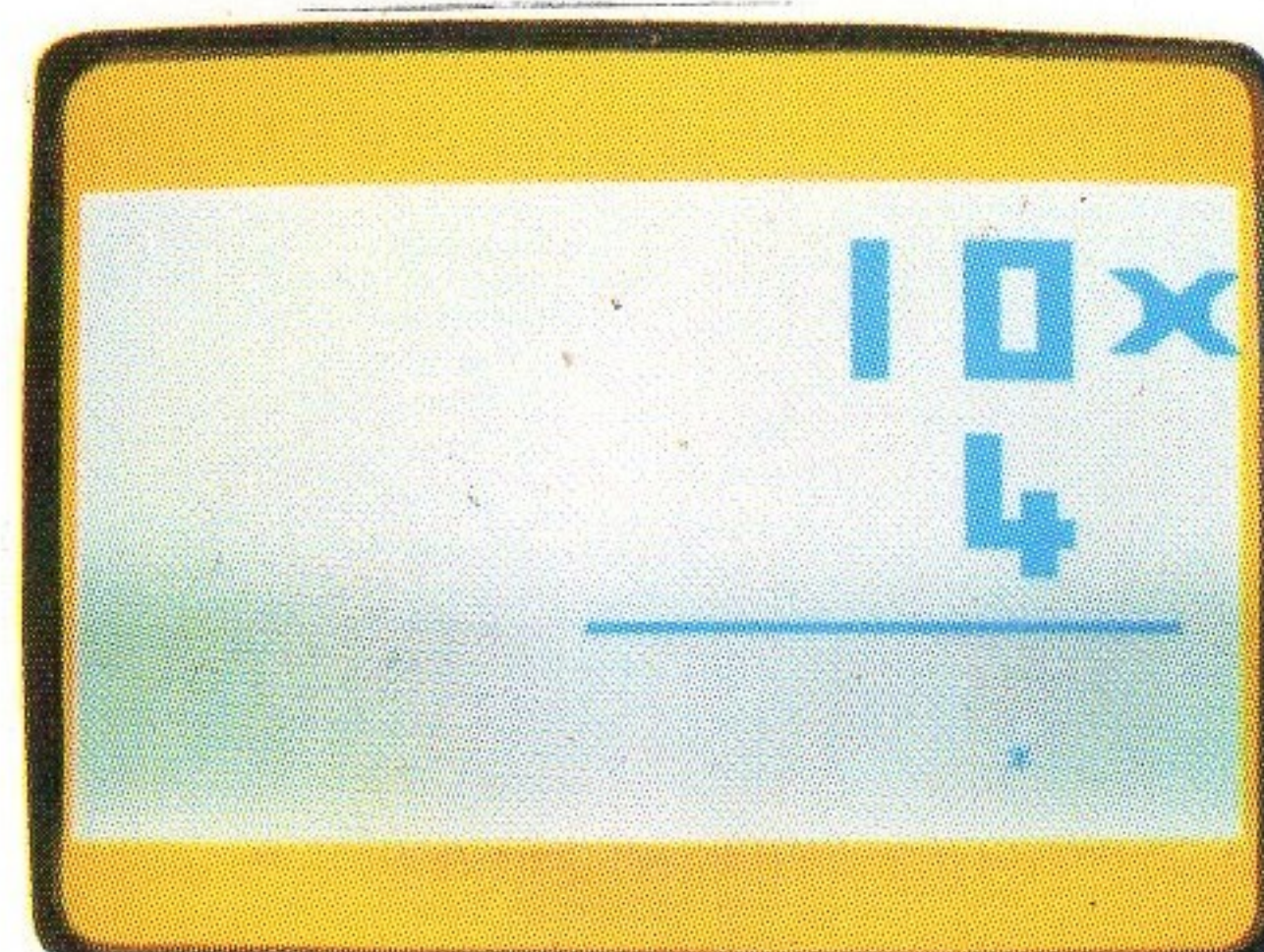
Mighty Writer

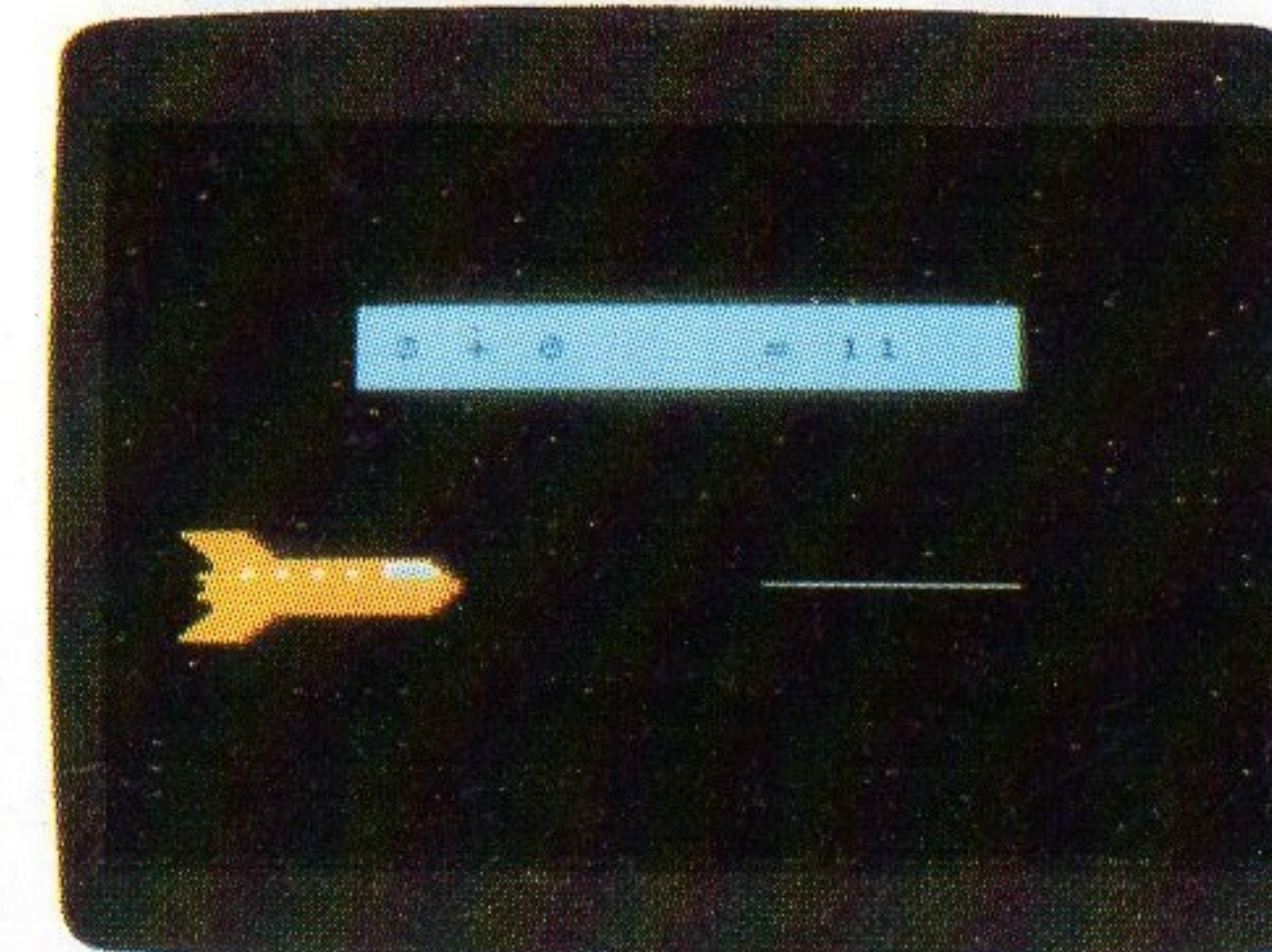
Giant Maths

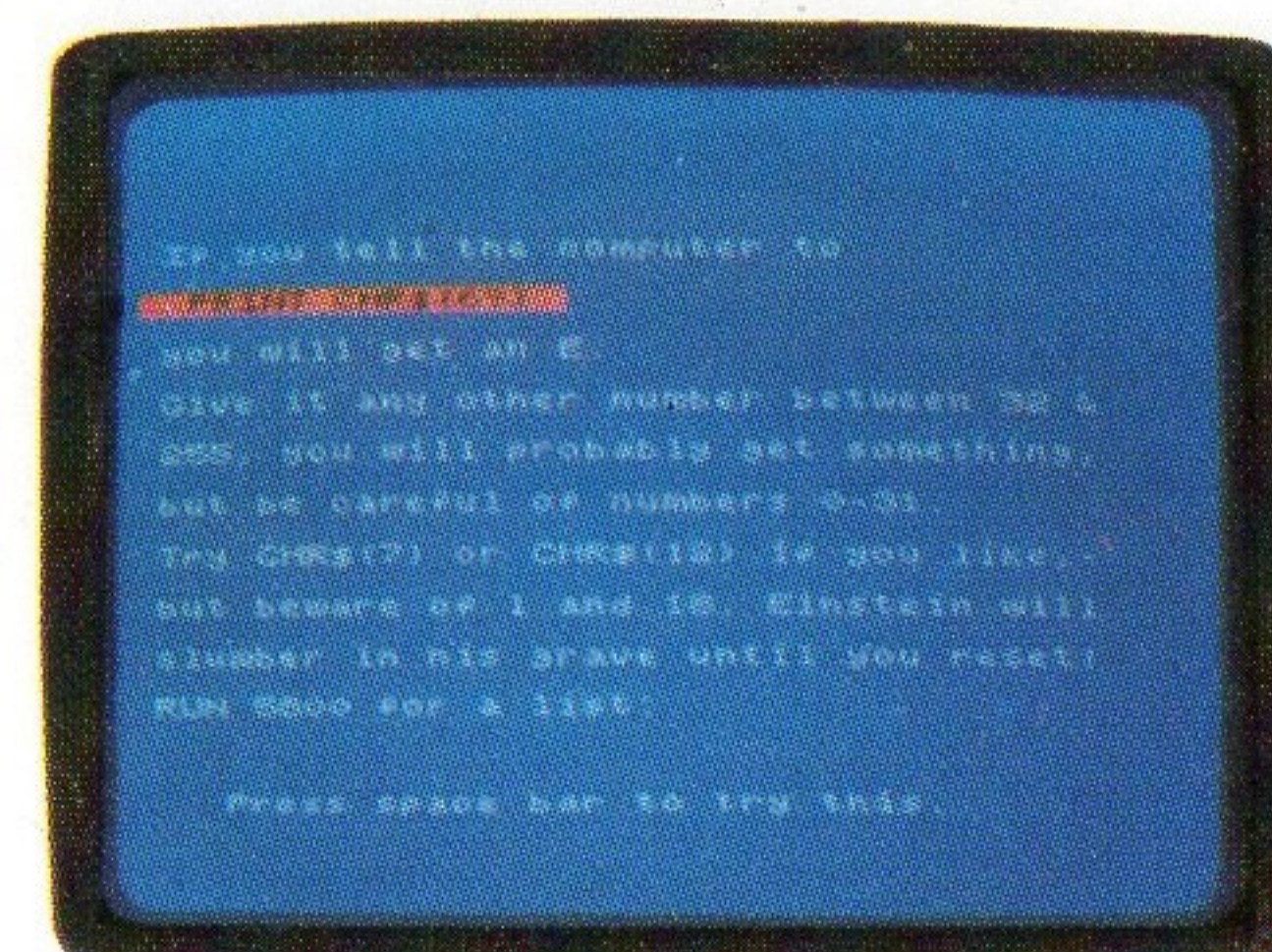
Rocket

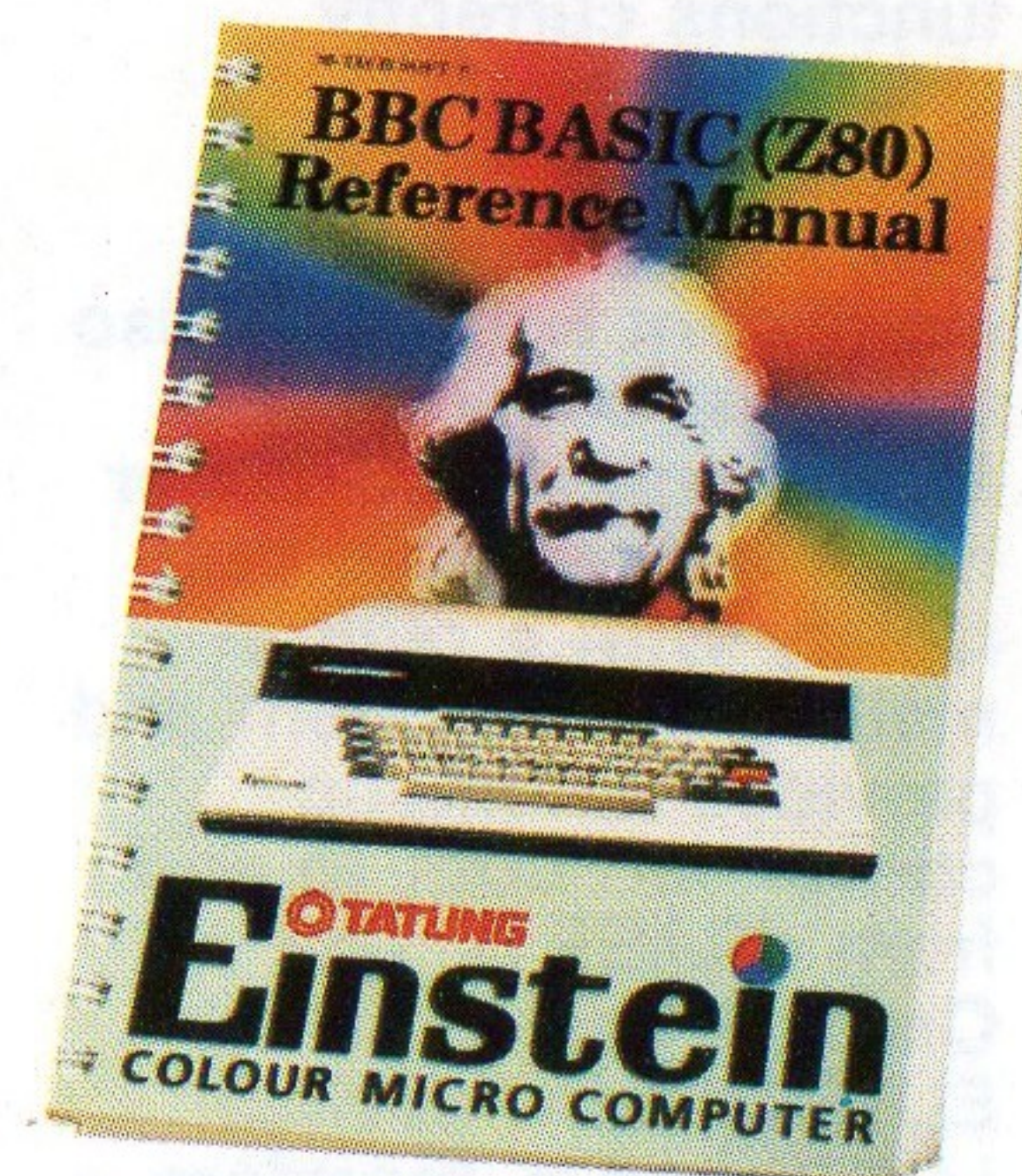
Basic Tutorial

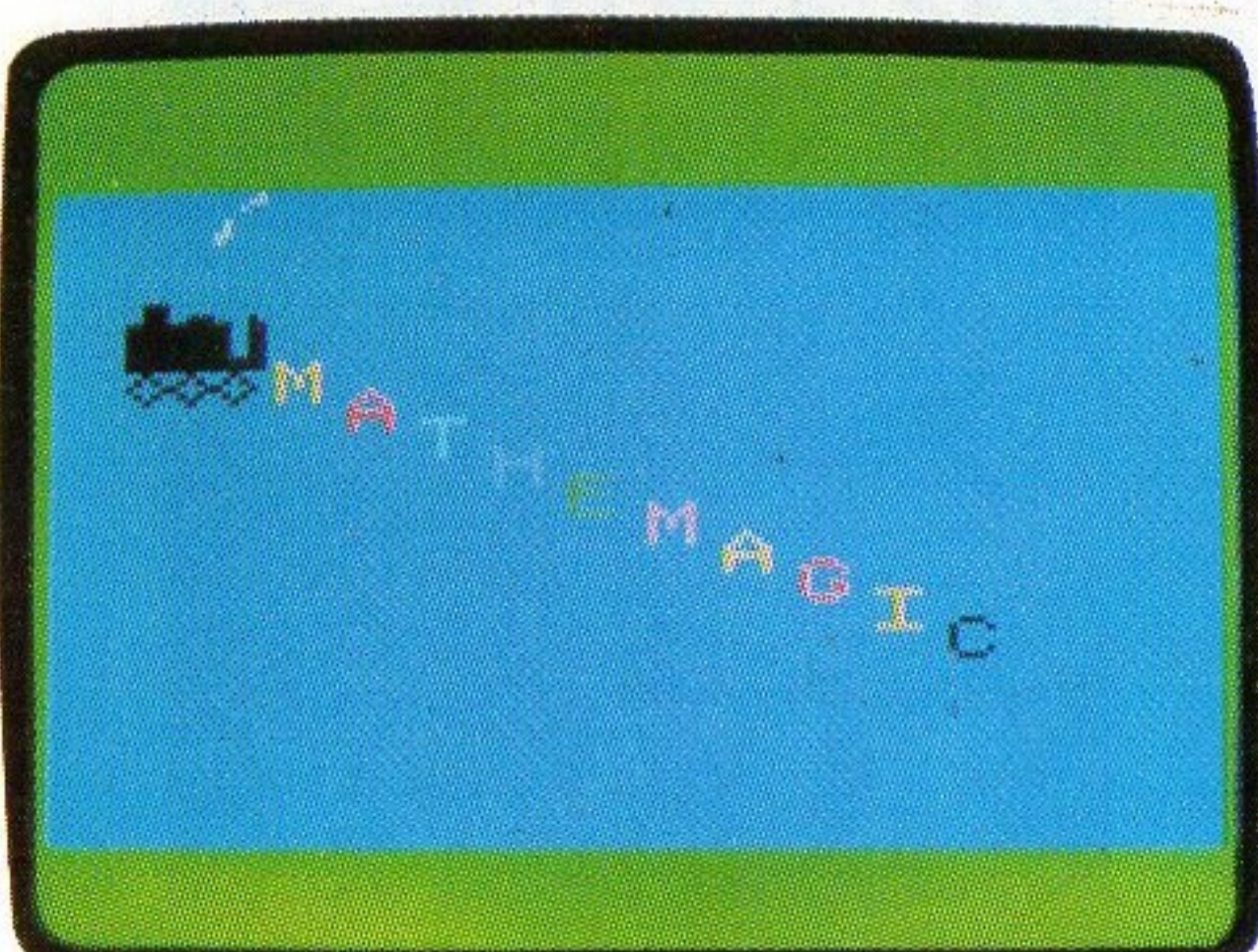
BBC Basic (Z80)

Mathemagic

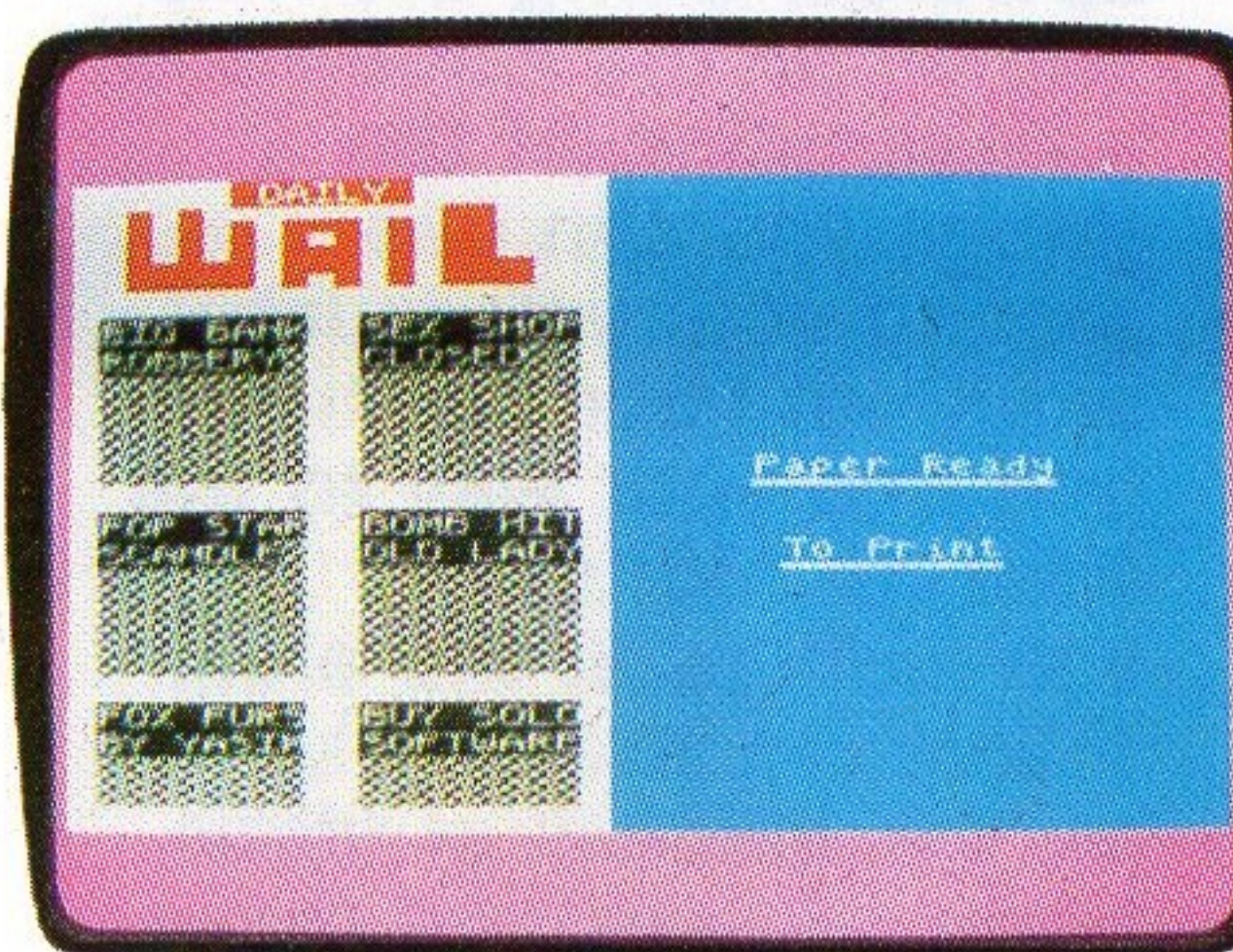

Scoop

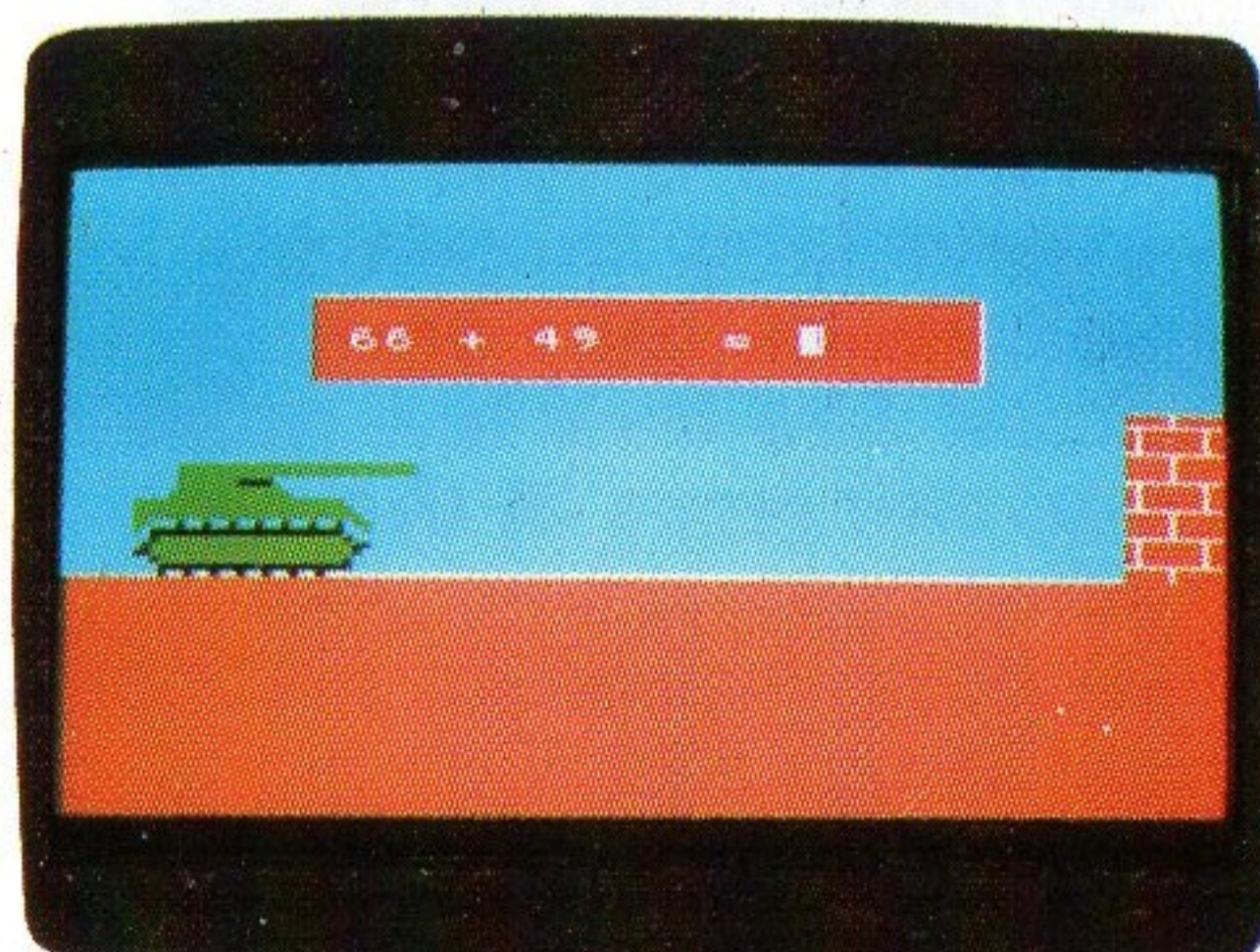

will occasionally demand a pay rise requiring a percentage calculation.



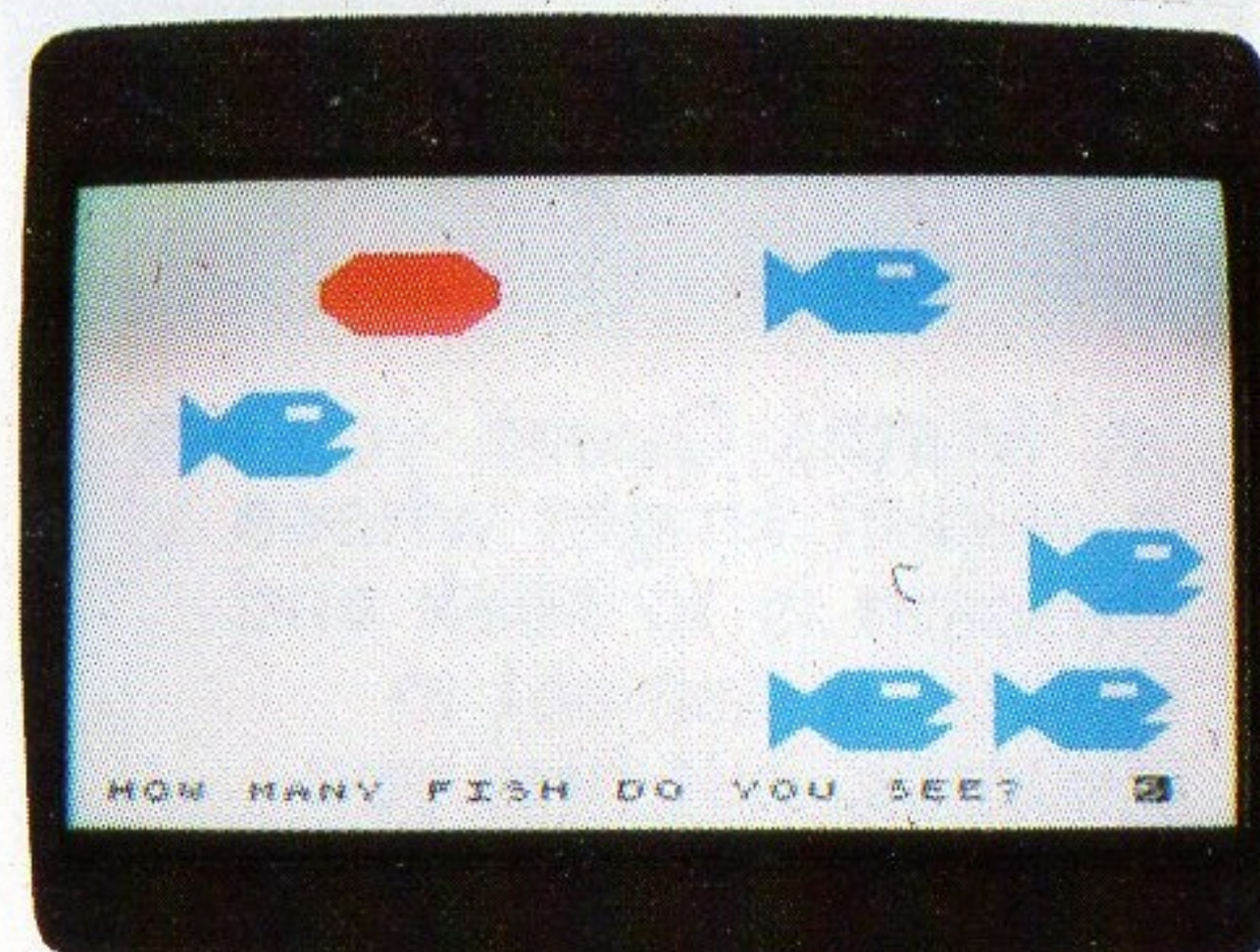
Maths Tank

Arithmetic can be fun is the idea behind this educational program for the 5-9 year olds. By getting the right answer to an arithmetic question the pupil causes his tank to fire its gun and knock down a brick wall. Getting the answer wrong means that there is a chance that the tank will be hit by a bomb that is dropped from the top of the screen. If the wrong answer is given three times, then the computer supplies the correct one. Good graphics and sound adds to the appeal of this educational program.



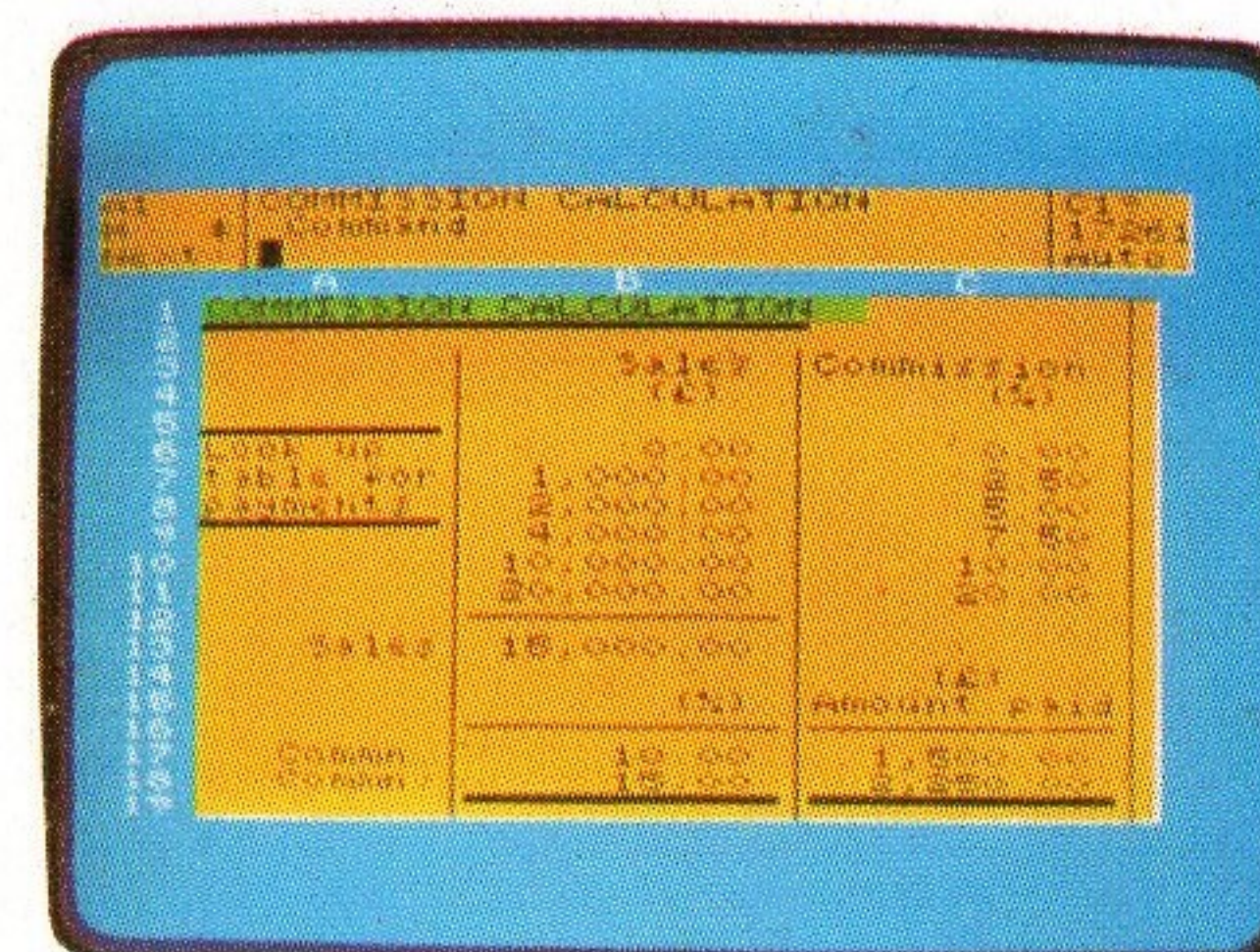
Counter Blast

This educational program is aimed at the child between 3-8 years of age. The pupil is shown a screen with a number of objects on it (such as fish, trains, dogs or birds). The pupil is then asked to count the objects and input the correct number into the computer. A right answer is rewarded by the objects being blasted off to the screen one by one. If the wrong answer is given three times, the computer will supply the right one. A score is given at the end of the program along with the best score of the session.



The Cracker

This package has been one of the most successful packages launched with the Einstein. It is a very powerful and well received spreadsheet along the lines of the well-known Visicalc and Multiplan programs. The **Cracker** checks all entries for logic and syntax and prevents the deletion of parts of the spreadsheets which affect other sections. It has the largest range of functions currently available on any spreadsheet and its number storage (15 significant figures) is also the most accurate. In addition, the **Cracker** has a limited data-base facility with a built-in mailing label system and provides automatic conversion both to and from dBASE II. The **Cracker** has IF THEN ELSE and DO-WHILE LOGIC and is, therefore, a "programmable" spreadsheet. This program is in colour so giving increased definition.



Database

An electronic card index system of 10 lines per card and up to 440 cards. Records are created containing 1 to 25 cards. Search, browse and print facilities are standard. Calculations can be performed and the files can be sorted with respect to any field. Special reports can be printed. The data resides in memory and is transferred to disk for storage. This very well documented program is easy to use and ideal for the first time user who wants a good working product to control his or her mailing list, stock or other records. Its many features have been groomed for greater ease of use.



Easidata

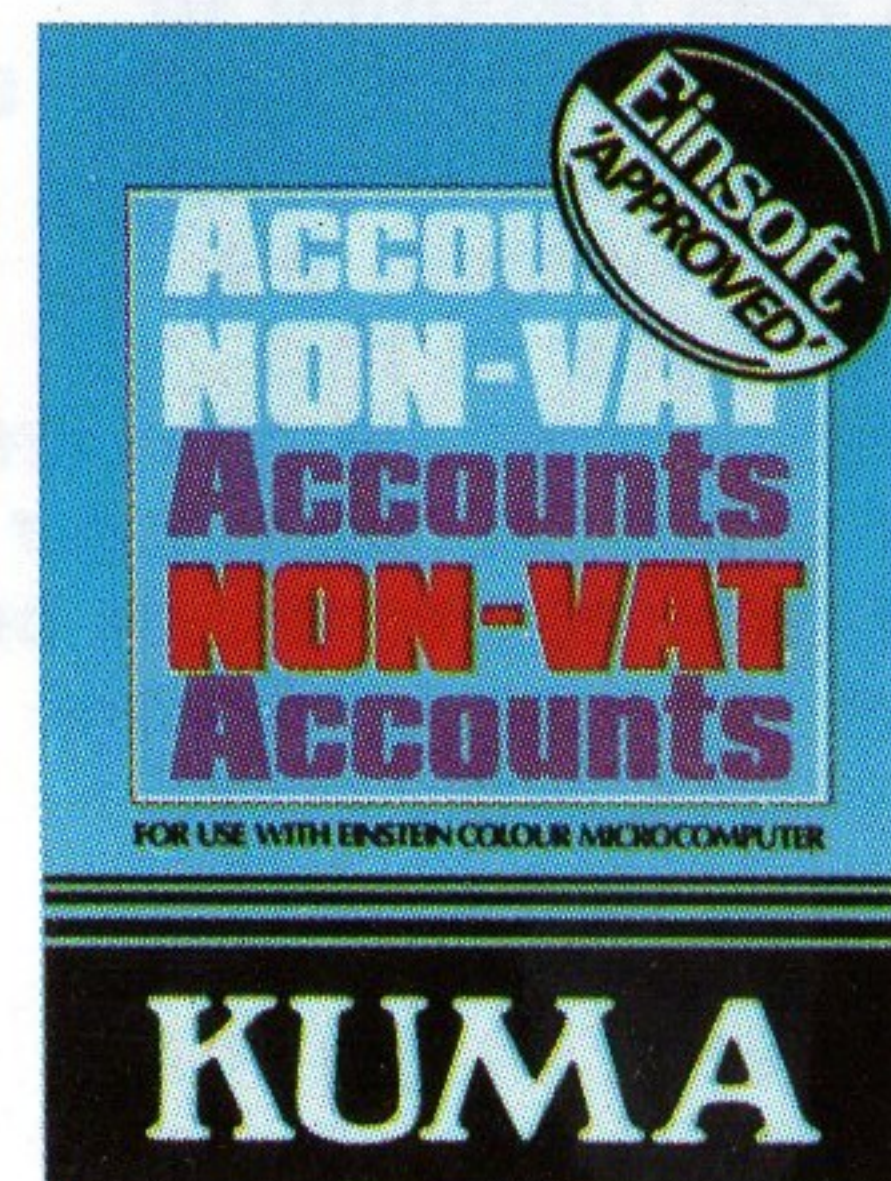
is a very fast information storage and retrieval program where the program only uses up 7 Kbytes of memory. The package is appropriately

called **Easidata** because a new file can be created in less than a minute, you can have up to 32 fields and the largest record can be almost the size of a screen (thus you can use the program for text storage, advertising display, etc.) The data itself is stored in memory but can, of course, be stored or retrieved on disk.



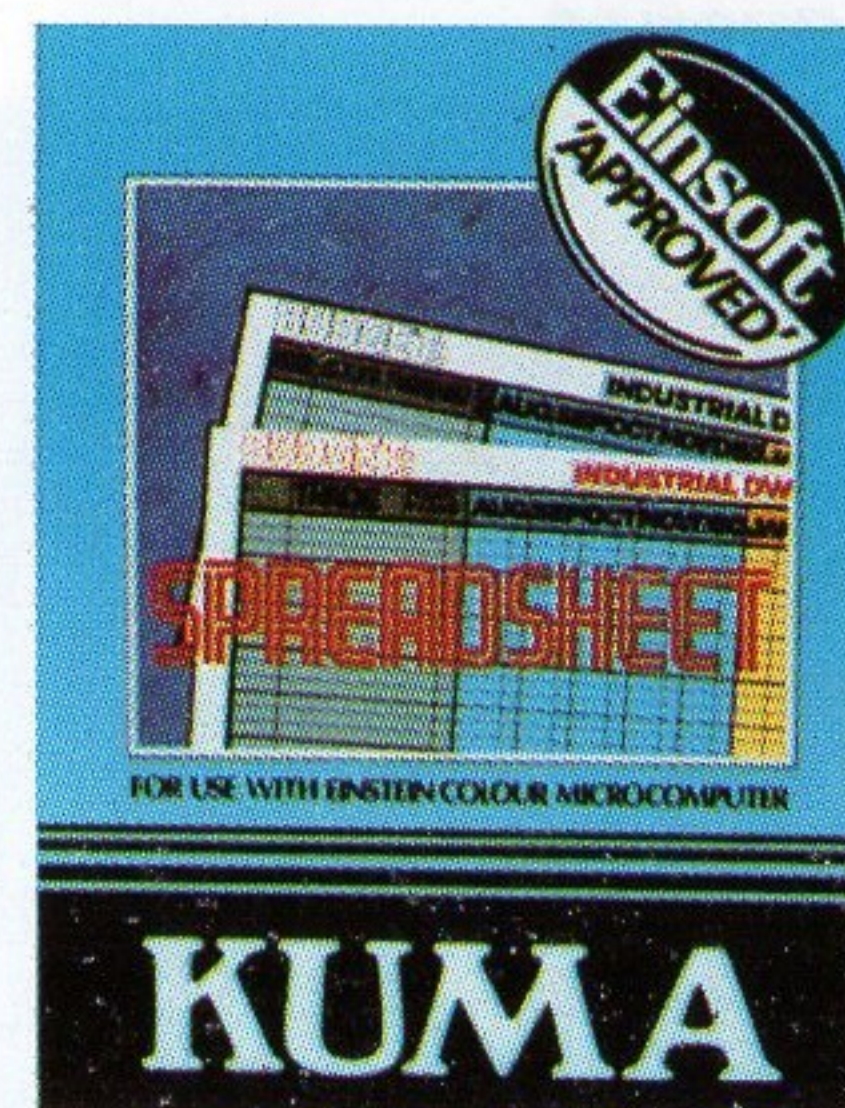
Non VAT Accounts

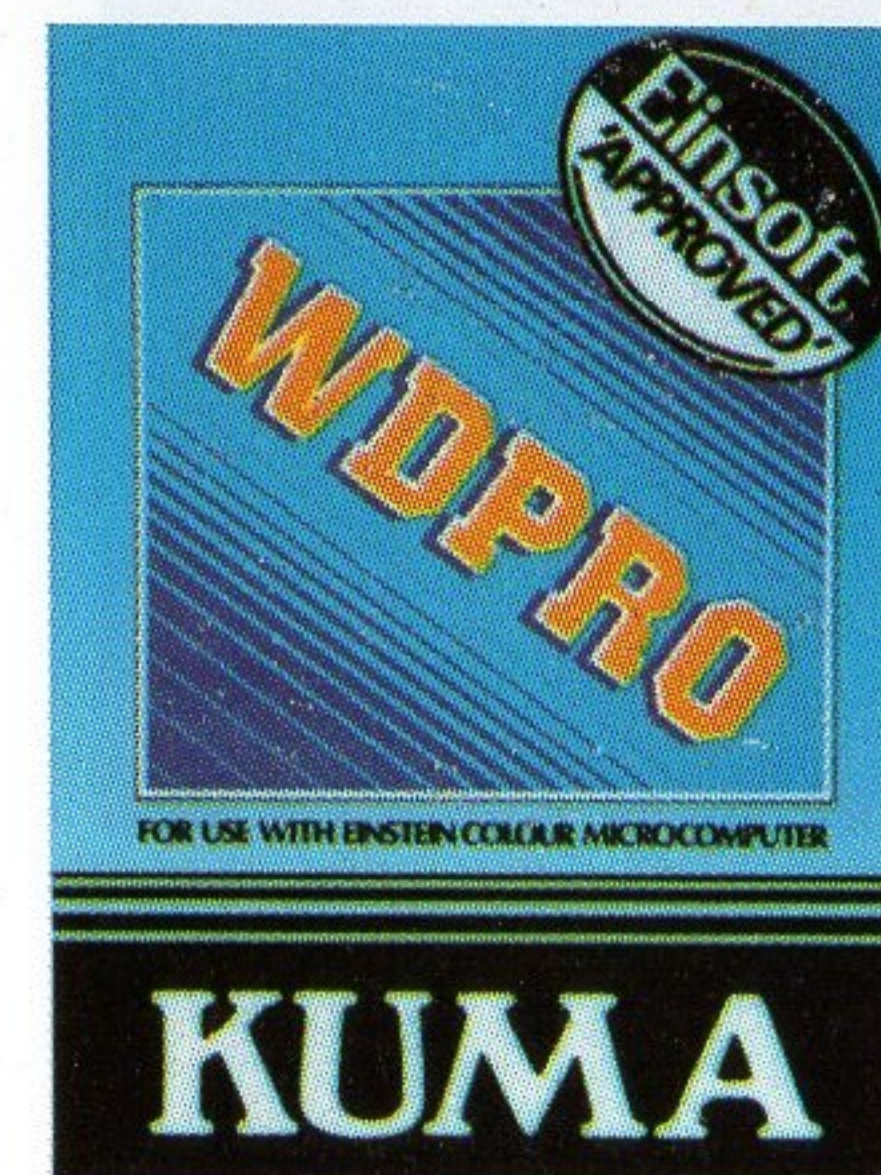
WDPRO
